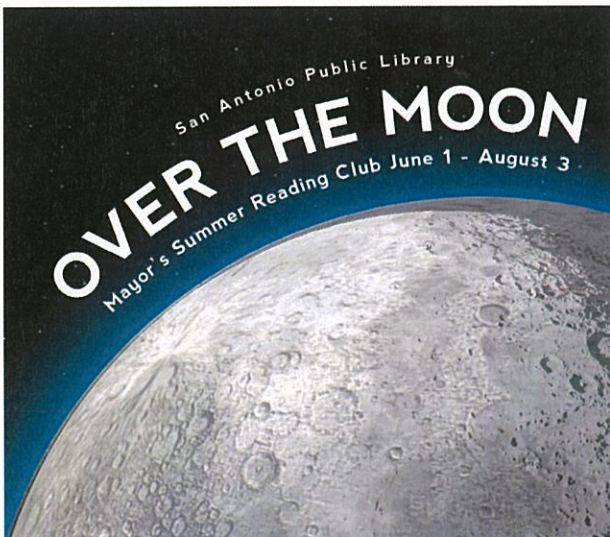
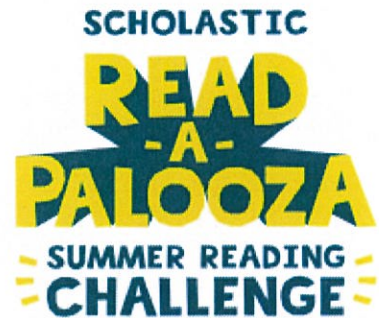


2019 Summer Reading Opportunities

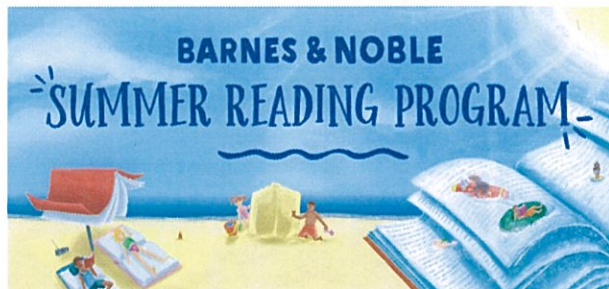
Keystone Parents, if you're looking for summer reading activities for your kids, there are many resources online, and San Antonio has much to offer. The following are just some of the opportunities you can find online and right here in the Alamo City.

The **Scholastic Read-a-Palooza Summer Reading Challenge** is a free, online reading program that motivates kids to keep reading over the summer. From May 6 to September 6, kids can enter their summer reading minutes online, unlocking digital rewards as they complete weekly reading challenges; and access book excerpts, videos, and other summer-exclusive content. Rising K-4 students have been registered by the Keystone Librarian, and student usernames and passwords went home before the end of the school year.
